MULTI USE GAMES AREA

Planning conditions were accepted yesterday, and we are hoping that work to create this area will begin in the next few weeks. In the first instance the plan is to have a tarmac surface with pitch lines. We hope to add artificial grass later (when there is the money). This area will be really useful for breaktime, lunch time and PE as we enter the winter months.

COVID-19 INFORMATION – SEPTEMBER 2020

It has been a real joy to have all our school family in school this week for the first time in months. The government has committed to prioritising keeping schools open, particularly primary schools, and taking other measures to avoid children across the country from being locked down again at home.

In school we are following the guidance from the government and our own risk assessments. The government's strategy of keeping the children in bubbles is the system we have running in school - classes keep apart from other classes. In the event of a COVID-19 case in school, the bubble system reduces the risk that it spreads quickly through the school.

You will have seen the measures outside of school but there are lots of new measures inside school including: screens in the school hall, sanistiser on all classroom doors, staff room screens, additional cleaning and lots more.

The children have adapted to these measures so quickly and there have been lots of happy children enjoying learning again, with their friends, in their classes.

WHEN CAN MY CHILD NOT COME TO SCHOOL?

If your child has a new and persistent cough or a high temperature, or has a loss of or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia), please follow the <u>guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection</u>, which sets out that they should self-isolate for at least 10 days and <u>arrange to have a test</u> as soon as you can to see if they have coronavirus (COVID-19). Please contact the school as soon as possible to let us know the result by e-mailing: head@garstang-st-thomas.lancs.sch.uk.

CAN MY CHILD COME TO SCHOOL WITH A COLD?

If your child has **any** of the COVID-19 symptoms listed above, they <u>must not</u> come to school, however, runny/blocked nose is not recognised as a symptom of COVID-19 that would require a test.

WHAT HAPPENS IF SOMEONE IN SCHOOL HAS SYMPTOMS?

If a child in school has COVID-19 symptoms, they will be isolated and cared for until they can be collected (staff will be using PPE in this event). If you receive a call to collect your child, please come as soon as possible to collect your child, arrange a test and follow the government guidance. Please let school know the result as soon as possible by e-mailing: head@garstang-st-thomas.lancs.sch.uk.

If there is a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 in school, we will work with Public Health England (PHE) Health Protection Team and will contact those who need to self-isolate. In the event of a class having to self-isolate, staff will continue teaching and learning using Google Classroom for the period.
