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# It's Black History Month. We've had a special focus this week. Here's a glimpse of what the children have been learning about:

**Reception class** have enjoyed reading All Are Welcome by <u>Alexandra Penfold</u> (click here for a sing-along <u>version</u>). The children have been thinking about how we are all different whilst reading this warm and inspiring book and that all are welcome in our school. Reception have also listened to <u>Floella Benjamin's</u> true story about coming to England.


**Year 1** have been inspired by the artist Alma Thomas and have enjoyed being creative following her style. The childen have also read together and discussed Mixed a Colourful Story by <u>Arree Chung</u>.

Year 3 have been learning about Harriet Tubman's incredible life story.

Year 4 have been learning about Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King Jnr, Jesse Owens and Nelson Mandela. In R.E. the children have been thinking about people needing to stand up to a Goliath of their own.



**Year 5** have researched the life and work of Martin Luther King and have thought about their own dreams of a better world. They have looked at Martin Luther King's Christian values and linked them to our school values. They have also taken part in a virtual author session with Joseph Coelho and have been inspired by his poetry.

Year 6 have been learning about #gamechangers - black sports women and men who have inspired us and made a difference. They have considered what it means to be #proudtobe...
