Good afternoon everyone,

We have had a very exciting week this week learning about darkness. We have been thinking about light and dark/day and night. We have created dark dens and enjoyed exploring colour and light using torches and head torches.

We have used dark and light colours when painting and using shaving foam in the tuff tray. Our younger children have been learning the rhyme 'Five Little Monkeys Jumping on the Bed' and we have been reading 'Can't You Sleep Little Bear?' and looked at the non-fiction book 'Light and Dark'. In phonics we have been practising tuning into sounds, guessing different animal noises.

In maths we started off by looking at patterns all around us and then started to look at repeating patterns and creating these with various objects including ourselves. On Wednesday afternoons our older children are lucky to have Mrs Taylor with them and this week they made some amazing pizzas! They looked very tasty.


