YOUR CHILD'S ANNUAL FLU VACCINATION 2023 (NASAL SPRAY)

This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and can cause serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of Flu. There may be a rebound in Flu levels this coming winter following low levels in the past 2 years. The vaccination is free and is a quick, simple, painless spray up the nose.

LANCASTER UNIVERSITY CLIMBING

We are excited to announce that we now offer the National Indoor Climbing Award Scheme (NICAS) climbing course for children aged 7-17. A separate class for those under 7 is also available (6-7 year old cheeky chimps).

<u>Launching on 4 September</u>, NICAS is a climbing award that can be achieved by children from just age 7, especially those who have a head for heights and an eye for knots.

There are 4 levels on offer starting from beginner up to advanced climber. Each level comes with a certificate that your child will receive once that level's criterion has been met. The key aim is to provide a safe introduction to climbing, while developing a range of skills and achieving a unique set of personal achievements.

Our classes will be separated into the following age groups, Classes are available to book onto until the end of the 3^{rd} week (24^{th} September):

6-7 Cheeky Chimps (NICAS can be started once they turn 7)


